# Report of Architectural Ideas by LIN△

Learning, Interacting and  
Networking in Architecture

LIN△ will bring together efforts to tackle climate and environmental challenges in the field of architecture in a European programme of research, workshops, architectural exhibitions, conferences and publishing projects.



The platform will involve European biennials, triennials and festivals, museums, galleries, foundations, research networks and laboratories, publishing houses and universities from 23 countries. The platform will be coordinated by the Faculty of Architecture at the University of Ljubljana and will be directed by Matevž Čelik, who was also responsible for the previously successful Future Architecture platform.

Matevž Čelik said: "The central philosophy of the platform will be to increase the environmental orientation of the architectural activity through young professionals' projects. The project offers a new working model in architecture where young professionals will be able to participate in education, research, production and dissemination of their ideas to adapt architecture to the circular economy and environmental challenges."

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It will support ideas that bring about the aesthetic, sustainable and inclusive elements of change needed to deliver the European Green Deal.

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LIN△ will support the work of young professionals in architecture: from research and prototyping to the dissemination of new knowledge and processes for environmentally responsible construction to the general public through architectural exhibitions and other events. The platform will offer opportunities for young architects to showcase their green ideas. It will support their work and enable them to collaborate with renowned European and Mediterranean universities, biennials and triennials, museums and other relevant partners in the field of architecture.

LIN△ will also organise regular conferences, gathering professionals, curators, producers and organisations working to bring about the urgent changes required of building and spatial planners by the increasingly visible consequences of the climate crisis. This year's LIN△ conference, which will mark the launch of the platform, will take place in Ljubljana in the autumn. In 2023, LIN△ will participate in the World Architecture Capital programme with a conference in Copenhagen, and in 2024 it will contribute to the 40th anniversary of the city's transformation for the Winter Olympics in Sarajevo. The platform programme will end in 2025 and, if reconfirmed, could continue until 2029.

As a LIN△ member, the IAF will run a Summer School and Emerging Architecture Writers Award each year. Our Summer Schools will consist of a series of workshops and panel discussions for creatives<sup>13</sup> in the field of architecture to advance emerging practice and focus on themes relevant to society, culture and the environment. Our Emerging Architecture Writers Awards will be run in collaboration with Dpr-Barcelona and will include a workshop, award, and publishing project intent on building a culture of independent writing and providing a platform and opportunities for people who wish to excel in this field.

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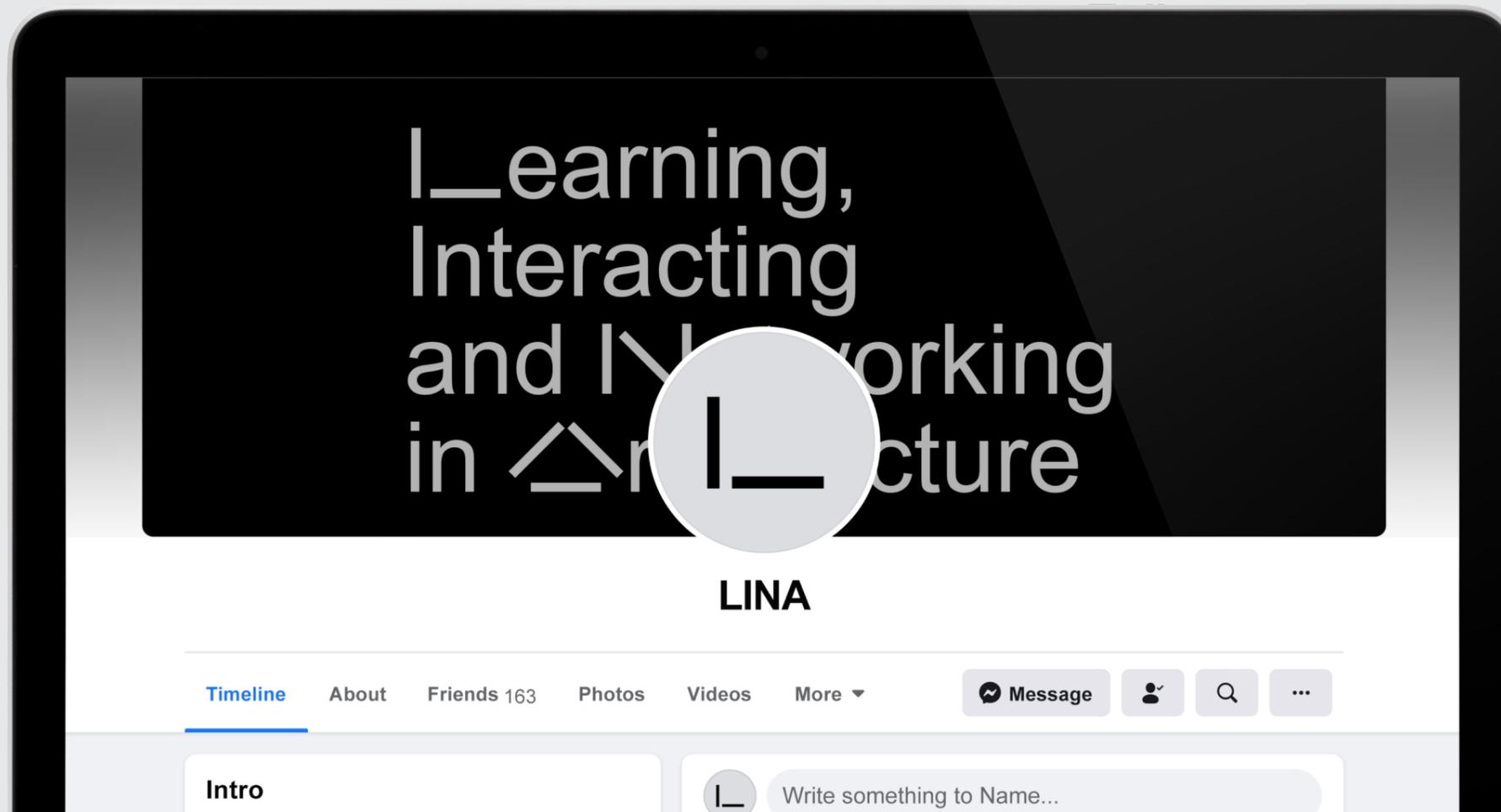
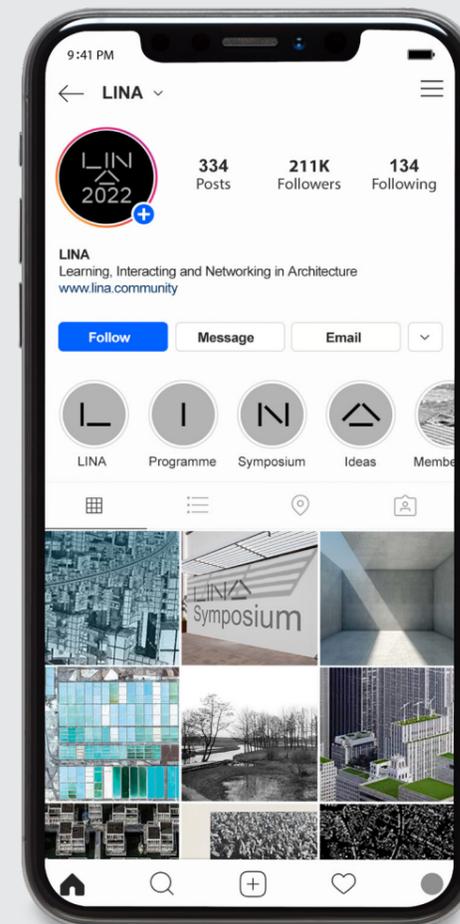
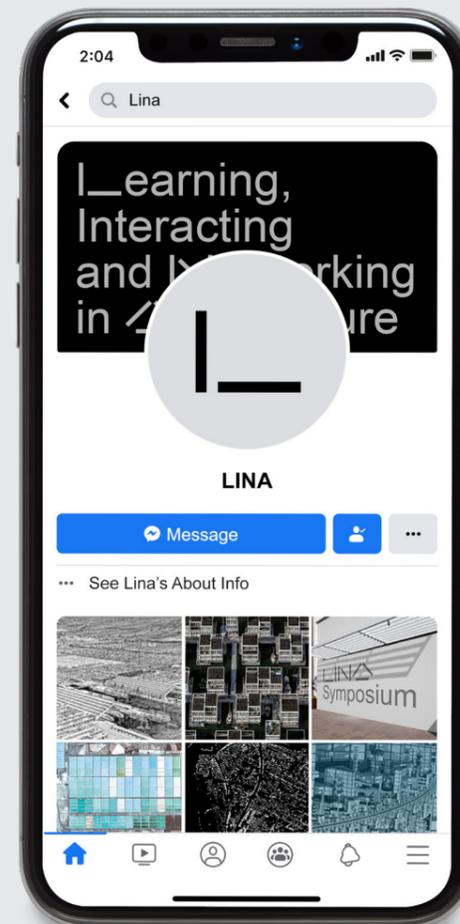
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#### On Design:

I\_L\_I\N\△'s identity design translates the theme of the I\new Bauhaus into a constructed typographic form that can be interwoven into a variety of textual outputs. The letters "I\_L\_I\N\△" are composed of the simplest character of the alphabet - "I". Specifically, "I" from △rial font (simple, universal, with wide language support - "people's" Helvetica). Our font "I\_L\_I\N\△" only takes up 3kB of space because it has only 3 characters. Colours: mostly greyscale - exceptions prove the rule.

#### On Sustainability:

The sustainability of I\_L\_I\N\△'s identity is determined by the relatively strict requirements of the competition's technical brief. For the translation into visual language we choose the following means: Displaying photos on request (otherwise not at all). △rial font (universal, language support) +3kB custom 4-glyph fontfile (I\_L\_I\N\△). Three typographic styles (sizes). Grey (not white) text on black (lower contrast helps reading). Black text not on white but on grey (again, the contrast and lower consumption). For print - reduced black to at least 90% for small texts and down to 25% of black for huge signs.
