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Uvod/Introduction

Interdisciplinarni doktorski študijski program Umetnost je v slovenskem visokošolskem prostoru novost. Je logični razvojni korak sodobne slovenske umetnosti, ki že od nekdaj ustvarja presežke tako v nacionalnem kot tudi v mednarodnem prostoru. Interdisciplinarni doktorski študij Umetnost je nadaljevanje in nadgradnja drugostopenjskega študija, katerega osrednji del je umetniško raziskovanje in oblikovanje vrhunsko usposobljenih umetnikov različnih področij. Učni izidi interdisciplinarnega doktorskega študija Umetnost se kažejo v vrhunsko usposobljenih ustvarjalcih (na umetniški in teoretski ravni), kompetentnih za mednarodno primerljivo umetniško prakso na izbranem področju.

Interdisciplinarni doktorski študij Umetnost je zasnovan kot raziskovalni program, ki na izbranih področjih umetnosti prispeva nabor metodologij dela, izhajajočih iz praktičnega umetniškega ustvarjanja. Metode raziskovanja so za razvjeta področja umetnosti ključnega pomena, saj prinašajo nabor prenosljivih in ponovljivih metod dela, ki jih je mogoče aplicirati po področjih v vedno bolj interdisciplinarnem raziskovalnem okolju. Študij temelji na ustvarjanju novih konceptov, poglobljenih spoznanj, znanj in veščin, ki izraščajo iz prakse in temelijo tako na individualnem kot na tiskem delu in interdisciplinarnem sodelovanju.

Doktorsko delo vključuje izvirno ustvarjalno prakso in tezo, ki praktično delo preizpršuje, kontekstualizira in kritično reflektira. S tem je doktorskemu študentu omogočeno usvajanje novih razumevanj in ustvarjanje novih znanj, ki ga bodo opremila za aktivno vodenje in delovanje v sodobnih družbenih kontekstih ter ustvarjalnih praksah. Vse našteto prek umetniške raziskave vodi k novim, občutno izboljšanim uvidom v praktično raziskovanje in delovanje ter k jasnemu razumevanju učinkov takšnega delovanja, z obvezno možnostjo diseminacije za nadaljnjo uporabo pridobljenih rezultatov.

The interdisciplinary doctoral programme in Art is a novelty in the Slovenian higher education landscape. It represents a logical developmental step for contemporary Slovenian art, which has consistently demonstrated noteworthy achievements both nationally and internationally. The programme is a continuation and enhancement of the second-cycle study, with the central focus being artistic research and the cultivation of highly qualified artists from various fields. The learning outcomes of the programme manifest in creators who are exceptionally skilled, both at the artistic and theoretical levels, and are competent for internationally comparable artistic practices in their chosen field.

The interdisciplinary doctoral programme in Art is designed as a research programme that contributes a range of working methodologies in selected areas of art, derived from practical artistic creation. Research methods are crucial for diverse fields of art, as they provide a set of transferable and replicable working methods applicable across disciplines in an increasingly interdisciplinary research environment. The programme is based on creating new concepts, in-depth insights, knowledge, and skills that emerge from practice and are grounded in teamwork and interdisciplinary collaboration.

The doctoral work includes original creative practice and a thesis that critically examines, contextualises, and reflects upon the practical work. In this way, doctoral students can gain new understandings and generate new knowledge that will equip them for active leadership and engagement in contemporary social contexts and creative practices. Through artistic research, all of the above leads to significantly improved insights into practical research and operation, as well as a clear understanding of the effects of such actions, with the mandatory option for disseminating the acquired results for further use.

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Temeljni cilji študijskega programa/Basic goals of the programme

Temeljni cilj študijskega programa je izobraziti doktorande za opravljanje najzahtevnejših del in nalog v umetniškem okolju, za samostojno umetniškoraziskovalno delo na razširjenem polju umetnosti in enakovredno vključevanje v mednarodno umetniškoraziskovalno okolje ter vzpostaviti možnosti za nadaljevanje študija na podoktorskih umetniških študijskih programih. Program je usmerjen v izoblikovanje široko razgledanega doktorja umetnosti, ki bo sposoben samostojno voditi in koordinirati najzahtevnejše raziskave in aplikacije znanj na izbranem področju umetnosti, tako v kontekstu interdisciplinarnih raziskav kot umetniških projektov. Doktorant bo usposobljen za raziskovalno delo na akademskem področju in zunaj njega ter več, samostojen in proaktiv v vodenju temeljnih, aplikativnih in razvojnih (interdisciplinarnih) raziskovalnih programov in projektov na področju umetnosti.

The fundamental objective of the programme is to educate doctoral candidates to undertake the most demanding tasks and responsibilities in the artistic environment, for independent artistic research work in the wider field of art, and for equivalent integration into the international artistic research environment. It aims to establish opportunities for further studies in post-doctoral artistic programmes. The programme is oriented towards shaping a broadly educated Doctor of Arts who will be capable of independently leading and coordinating the most advanced research and applications of knowledge in their chosen field of the arts, both within the context of interdisciplinary research and artistic projects. The doctoral candidate will be trained for research work in the academic sphere as well as beyond, and will be skilled, independent, and proactive in leading fundamental, applied and developmental (interdisciplinary) research programmes and projects in the field of the arts.

The interdisciplinary doctoral programme in Art integrates practical and theoretical elements from selected artistic fields. The programme combines contemporary didactic approaches with individual and group methods of acquiring, using, and applying artistic skills and knowledge. Upon completion of the study programme, students, through the vertical and horizontal integration of study content, will develop the following competencies:

1. Analytical skills;
2. Competent use of methodological tools (independently conducting, coordinating, leading, and organising artistic practice and research; proficient use and further development of various artistic research methods and techniques; autonomy and self-initiative in research work);

 - Portfolio of artworks to date: 25%
 - Interview with the candidate: 40%

Vsebina predmeta se povezuje z individualnim delom doktorandov, ki skozi raziskavo različnih primerov razvijajo lastno doktorsko delo. Teorijo svojega dela koncretizirajo s skico ali pilotskim projektom lastne umetniške prakse, ki je uvod v samostojno doktorsko delo.</p> <p>Predavanja predmeta obravnavajo različne vidike in komponente arhitekturne in krajinskoarhitekturne discipline ter povezujejo kritično teorijo, refleksijo in projektiranje z družbenopolitičnim in kulturnim kontekstom, v primeru krajinske arhitekture pa nujno tudi z geografskim. Predmet je osredotočen na oblikovanje arhitekturnega/krajinskoarhitekturnega problema ter na odnos do drugih disciplin, kot so tehnika, filozofija, umetnost, znanost itd., ter na integrirano rabo drugih disciplin v projektnem delu. To se izraža v konceptualizaciji posameznih del ter načinu predstavitev arhitekturne misli.</p>	<p>Doctoral students also focus on filmicity, the philosophy of film and television, explore ontological authenticity, and deal with kinaesthesia and synaesthesia in the performing arts. An important part of the course is also the exploration of film narrative styles such as primitive, classical and modernist, and the understanding of the concept of time in audiovisual art.</p> <p>Particular emphasis is also given to the study of intermediality between the cinematic and the non-filmic, and to the exploration of the possibilities of interweaving different artistic media.</p> <p>The course aims to synthesise an understanding of the theoretical frameworks that shape the performing arts and to equip them with critical tools for the analysis and interpretation of works of art. PhD students are encouraged to think, research and reflect independently, enabling them to develop their own artistic approaches and research projects within the performing and audiovisual arts.</p> <p>Research in the course can be carried out within the disciplines of the performing arts and audiovisual arts or in an interdisciplinary way, interweaving different artistic practices and linking with other areas of study in the third-cycle study programme of Art and other academic fields.</p> <p>Course title: Conceptualisation of Architecture and Landscape Architecture as an Artistic Practice</p> <p>Content: The course deals with the architectural and/or landscape-architectural project as a tool for research and reflection. The content of the course is linked to the individual work of doctoral students, who develop their own doctoral thesis through the research of different cases. They concretise the theory of their work with a sketch or a pilot project of their own artistic practice, which serves as a prelude to their independent doctoral thesis.</p> <p>The lectures of the course address different aspects and components of the disciplines of architecture and landscape architecture, and relate critical theory, reflection and design to the socio-political and cultural context and, as inevitable in the case of landscape architecture, the geographical one. The course focuses on the formulation of the architectural/landscape-</p>
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<p>Doktorandi preučujejo načine usmerjanja arhitektovega znanja in razmišljanja v produkcijo skozi artikulacijo vseh realnih zunanjih dejavnikov ter odzive nanje. This is expressed in the conceptualisation of the individual works and the way in which architectural thought is presented.</p> <p>The doctoral students study the ways in which the architect's knowledge and thinking are channelled into production through the articulation of, and responses to, all real external factors. The way in which an architectural and landscape-architectural project is presented (drawing, model, etc.) is also studied in terms of understanding and using visual language as an integral part of the project.</p> <p>In the course, doctoral students analyse the most important currents, theories and concrete projects that have shaped architecture and/or landscape architecture through critical discourse. An understanding of the foundations of architectural and landscape-architectural design and their interdisciplinary integration in the design of space is also emphasised. The course also encourages reflection on the doctoral student's own work.</p> <p>Doctoral students consider both historical examples and examples of current production, according to their own orientations and interests, which they pursue within the field of architecture and landscape architecture or in an interdisciplinary way by interweaving different artistic practices and linking them to other areas of study in the third-cycle study programme of Art and other academic fields.</p>
<p>Naslov: Tekstilne in oblačilne prakse</p>	<p>Course title: Textile and Clothing Practices</p>

Vsebina:

Predmet omogoča doktorandom teoretično refleksijo na področju umetniškega raziskovanja tekstilij in oblačil. Doktorandi analizirajo fenomene in specifike umetniškega področja tekstilij in oblačil ter povezujejo tekstilno in modno oblikovanje s potrošnjo, komunikacijskimi procesi, kulturnimi praksami in sistemi produkcije. Doktorandi se učijo interpretirati in kritično argumentirati, presojati, razvrščati in potrjevati vsebine ter rezultate svojega dela ter vzpostavljati hipoteze in zaključke, pri čemer poudarjajo interdisciplinarni pristop.

Pri predmetu doktorandi raziskujejo povezanost med oblikami potrošnje, odnosi, komunikacijskimi procesi, kulturnimi praksami ter sistemi in strukturami produkcije na tem področju. Pri tem se predmet osredotoča na razumevanje tekstilnega in modnega oblikovanja kot del širšega fenomena, ki odraža globlje in bolj strukturirane družbene spremembe ter dogodke. Proučuje tudi procese in metodologije, ki se uporabljajo v sodobnem modnem in tekstilnem okolju ter umetnosti.

Content:

The course provides doctoral students with theoretical reflection in the field of artistic research on textiles and clothing. Doctoral students analyse the phenomena and specificities of the artistic field of textiles and clothing and relate textile and fashion design to consumption, communication processes, cultural practices and production systems. Doctoral students learn to interpret and critically argue, judge, classify and validate the content and results of their work and to establish hypotheses and conclusions, emphasising an interdisciplinary approach.

In the course, doctoral students explore the interconnections between forms of consumption, attitudes, communication processes, cultural

In doing so, it focuses on understanding textile and fashion design as part of a broader phenomenon that reflects deeper and more structured social changes and events. The course also examines the processes and methodologies used in contemporary fashion, textile and art environments. It pays particular attention to contemporary practices and actors in the field of fashion and textile design, carrying out targeted case studies. At the same time, it follows contemporary trends in textile and clothing design, and delves into contemporary textile and clothing technologies.</p> <p>Particular emphasis is placed on contemporary social movements, especially sustainable design, which plays an important role in the field of textile and fashion design. The different fields in this field are examined and the possibilities of integrating them into interdisciplinary practices are explored, allowing for innovative and holistic approaches to creation.</p> <p>The analysis of specific anthropological and psycho-sociological theories, which are considered key in the development of fashion studies, is an important part of doctoral students' research work. The knowledge gained through this allows them to better understand and explore the field and to contribute to the development and advancement of the fashion industry.</p> <p>A doctoral student's individual artistic research project work is an opportunity to integrate, verify and build on the knowledge they already acquired. In their work, they should devote special attention to artistic research ethics and focuses on critical reflection and respect for humanistic values.</p> <p>Research in the course can be carried out within the field of textile and clothing practice or in an interdisciplinary way by interweaving different artistic practices and linking with other areas of study in the third-cycle study programme of Art and other academic fields.</p>
<p>Naslov: <i>Raziskovanje v umetnosti I</i></p> <p>Vsebina: Raziskovanje v umetnosti I zagotavlja doktorandu na začetni stopnji reflektiran in sistematičen uvid v metodološko naravo in metodološke posebnosti raziskovalnega dela na področju umetnosti. V tem pogledu je predmet vsebinsko zasnovan kot propedevтика predmeta Raziskovanje v umetnosti II, katerega temeljni nameni so aplikativne, tj. področnospecifične narave.</p> <p>Predmet ponuja doktorandu uvid v interno naravo fenomenov, kakršni so: problemska situacija, formuliranje raziskovalnih problemov in hipotez, načrtovanje in izvedba individualnega umetniškega</p>	<p>Course title: <i>Research in Art I</i></p> <p>Content: At its initial stage, Research in Art I provides doctoral students with a reflective and systematic insight into the methodological nature and methodological features of the research work in the area of art. In this respect, the course is</p>

<p>raziskovalnega projekta, evalvacija raziskovalnih rezultatov, prezentacija raziskovalnih rezultatov v strokovni javnosti itd. Predmet opravljajo študentje vseh področij programa.</p> <p>Naslov: <i>Raziskovanje v umetnosti II</i></p> <p>Vsebina: Predmet Raziskovanje v umetnosti II je praktična aplikacija vsebin, konceptov in znanj, ki jih je študent pridobil pri predmetu Raziskovanje v umetnosti I. Obsegja področja likovna umetnost, oblikovanje (vizualne komunikacije, industrijsko oblikovanje, unikatno oblikovanje), glasba, gledališče, film, radio in televizija, arhitektura in krajinska arhitektura ter oblikovanje tekstilij in oblačil. Glede na naravo ustvarjalnega dela v umetnosti, ki ima karakter procesualnosti in razvijanja ter obliko individualne ali timske kreacije, tvorita področnospecifični okvir raziskovanja na tretji stopnji izobraževanja umetnosti dve koordinirani metodološki matrici: (i) matrica akcijskega raziskovanja (action research) in (ii) matrica posebnih metod raziskovalnega dela na posameznem umetniškem področju.</p> <p>Akcijsko raziskovanje je oblika praktičnega raziskovanja za ugotavljanje, odkrivanje in refleksijo dejstev, ciljev in problemov, ki jih zaznavajo posamezniki v svoji lastni ustvarjalni praksi (practice based research). Pedagoški potencial akcijskega raziskovanja in področnospecifičnih metod raziskovalnega dela prihaja do izraza skozi praktično metodološko podporo doktorandovemu individualnemu raziskovalnemu delu (uvidevanje in formuliranje problemov, eksperimentiranje z alternativami,</p>	<p>designed as the introduction to Research in Art II, whose basic aim is of an applicative, i.e. area-specific nature.</p> <p>The course provides an insight into the internal nature of phenomena such as problem situation, formulation of research problems and hypotheses, design and performance of an individual artistic research project, evaluation of the research results, presentation of the research results to the professional public, etc. The course is taken by the students from all study fields of the programme.</p> <p>Course title: <i>Research in Art II</i></p> <p>Content: Research in Art II is a practical application of the content, concepts and knowledge acquired during the course in Research in Art I. It covers the fields of fine arts, design (visual communications, industrial design, applied arts), music, theatre, film, radio and television, architecture, landscape architecture and textile and clothing design. In line with the nature of the creative work in art, whose characteristics are processuality and development, taking the forms of individual or team creation, two coordinated methodological matrices provide a field-specific framework for the research at the third level of arts education: (i) the matrix of action research and (ii) the matrix of specific methods of the research work in a particular art field.</p> <p>Action research is a form of practical research aimed at identifying, establishing and reflecting about the facts, objectives and problems that individuals perceive in their own artistic practices (practice-based research). Researchers examine and determine the causes of their actions, thus opening the door to non-trivial changes and progress in their work. In the frame of the third-level research, action research has the following characteristics in the field of art: the ideas and problems stem from the concrete needs of practice; the objectives do not refer to the verification of theories but to the change in the context of practice; the obtained results are in the form of applicative operators allowing their direct use in practice; research situations are treated holistically; researchers are actively involved in the processes and interactively connected with the other participants in these processes (mentor, curator, users, audience, etc.).</p> <p>Special methods of research work bring dispositional, i.e. practical, skill-related and</p>

To po eni strani terja, da se študentje pregledno seznanijo z nekaterimi historično najvplivnejšimi teorijami umetnosti kakor tudi z raznolikostjo sodobnih refleksij o umetnosti, po drugi strani pa terja kritični razmislek o izbranih posameznih primerih sodobnih umetnostnih praks. Glede na to, da gre za skupni predmet za vse različne usmeritve, bodo izbrani primeri iz različnih umetnostnih praks, predmet pa bo navajal študente posameznih usmeritev k temu, da se poglabljajo tudi v umetnostna dela drugih področij in se podajo v premislek namenov, dometa in konteksta umetnostnih prizadevanj in njihovega širšega družbenega in miselnega okvira. The pedagogical potential of action research and field-specific methods of research becomes instrumental through a practical methodological support provided to individual doctoral research (identifying and formulating problems, experimenting with alternatives, designing non-trivial alternatives, deciding between different alternatives, searching for second-order solutions / second-order changes according to Watzlawick/, methodologically reflecting on the performance stages of a research project, etc.).</p> <p>Constituting an applicative infrastructure of artistic research, field-specific methods are strictly linked to concrete research problem situations that students bring into the pedagogical process with their research problems and topics. On the one hand, these methods help students solve entirely concrete research problems, on the other hand, they provide for the students' methodological training for research confrontations with other, never entirely predictable problem situations. The field specifics of these methods are only partly noticeable at the descriptive level, but they become more obvious from the reading list below, covering different fields, and, above all, from direct applicative conditions, defined by artistic expression media with their presuppositions and communicational nature. The basis for the course realisation is individual work with students focussing on their research projects.</p> <p>Course title: <i>Theories of Art</i></p> <p>Content: The aim of the course is to develop and to encourage critical reflection of art practices. This requires, on the one hand, that the students acquire a general knowledge about the most influential theories of art and about the diversity of contemporary reflections on art, and, on the other hand, a critical assessment of selected particular cases of contemporary art practices. Given that this is a general course intended for all different programmes, the cases will be chosen from different art practices and students of different programmes will be encouraged to address artworks from other artistic fields and to reflect on the aims, impact and context of artistic endeavours and their wider social and conceptual frame. The aim of the course is also to encourage creativity and invention and at the same time to equip students with the critical conceptual tools for</p>
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<p>umetnosti v globaliziranem svetu; umetnost pred izvivi novih tehnologij.</p> <p>Naslov: Umetniški seminar 1 in 2</p> <p>Vsebinsko dovršenost študijskega programa poleg obveznih temeljnih predmetov ter skupnih metodoloških in teoretskih predmetov, ki zagotavljajo temeljna vedenja, vsebinsko nadgrajujejo umetniški seminarji. Ti omogočajo ožjo usmeritev v izbrano smer študija, ki jo določata tema in področje umetniškega raziskovanja v polju doktorskega dela.</p> <p>Umetniški seminarji se bodo izvajali za skupine študentov iste usmeritve ali kot individualno delo s študenti, na organizirane seminarje pa bodo vabljeni tudi študenti drugih področij. Umetniška seminarja 1 in 2 namreč omogočata in spodbujata povezovanje vseh desetih umetniških študijskih področij. Zasnova obeh predmetov omogoča kar največjo stopnjo prilagajanja študentu in temi njegovih umetniških vsebin. Opisano se zrcali v vsebinski fleksibilnosti, ažurnem vključevanju najnovejših raziskovalnih spoznanj in študijske literature v pedagoški proces, sprotinem prilagajanju smiselnemu izbranih metod in procesov umetniškega raziskovanja ter kritičnem vključevanju razumevanja aktualnih problemov v specifiki študentovega umetniškega področja.</p> <p>Na umetniških seminarjih se bodo doktorski študenti lahko srečevali z različnimi strokovnjaki, predavatelji in drugimi študenti ter predstavljalci, argumentirali in reflektirali svoje raziskovalne projekte, ideje, napredek in rezultate ter prejemali povratne informacije od nosilcev in izvajalcev predmeta, kot tudi drugih študentov. The aim is not merely to provide a philosophical and wider theoretical reflection on art, but also to consider the reverse reflection about the ways in which art itself thinks and produces concepts, so that theory also has to learn from it.</p> <p>Particular focus will be given to the present situation of art in three respects: the role of art after the demise of modernism; the role of art in a globalised world; and art confronting the challenges presented by new technologies.</p> <p>Course title: Artistic Seminar 1 and 2</p> <p>In addition to the compulsory core subjects and the joint methodological and theoretical subjects that provide the basic knowledge, the content of the study programme is enhanced by artistic seminars. These provide a narrower focus on the chosen field of study, which is determined by the theme and area of artistic research in the field of doctoral thesis.</p> <p>The artistic seminars will be held for groups of students of the same major or as individual work with students, and students from other disciplines will also be invited to participate in the organised seminars. Artistic Seminars 1 and 2 enable and encourage the integration of all ten artistic fields of study. The approach of both courses allows for the greatest possible degree of adaptation to the student and the subject of their artistic content. This is reflected in the flexibility of the content, the up-to-date integration of the latest research findings and study literature into the pedagogical process, the ongoing adaptation of meaningfully selected methods and processes of artistic research, and the critical integration of an understanding of current issues within the specifics of the student's artistic field.</p> <p>In the framework of the art seminars, PhD students will have the opportunity to meet with various experts, lecturers and other students to present, argue and reflect on their research projects, ideas, progress and results, and to receive feedback from the course tutors, lecturers and other students. The art seminars are also an opportunity to network with colleagues from other artistic and scientific fields, as well as to engage in interdisciplinary artistic research that can contribute to a broader understanding of the problem and deepen PhD students' artistic research process.</p>
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<p>ECTS izbirnih vsebin iz drugih programov UL in primerljivih programov tujih univerz.</p>	<p><u>External elective subject</u></p> <p>The external elective subject differs from artistic seminars primarily in the provision that the candidate, together with the mentor, usually selects a subject at one of the recognised universities, thus giving the candidate the opportunity for artistic work abroad and exposure to various artistic research practices. Načini ocenjevanja/Grading system

Umetniško delo in znanje študentov se preverja in ocenjuje po posameznih predmetih in drugih učnih enotah, kot to predvideva posamezen učni načrt.

In accordance with the Statute of the University of Ljubljana, examination results are graded on a scale from 5 to 10, with passing grades considered to be from 6 to 10. Academic requirements can also be assessed with the grades: passed with distinction, passed or failed.

The artistic work and knowledge of students are evaluated and assessed for each subject and other learning units, as stipulated in the respective curriculum.

Študent mora za dokončanje študija in pridobitev umetniškega naslova doktor/doktorica umetnosti uspešno opraviti vse s programom določene študijske obveznosti in uspešno javno zagovarjati doktorsko delo v skupnem obsegu 240 ECTS. Obveznost doktoranda je najmanj ena javna predstavitev rezultatov umetniškoraziskovalnega dela (ob oddaji doktorskega dela v oceno), ki jo posamezne umetniške discipline priznavajo kot ustrezno. Doktorand mora najpozneje ob oddaji doktorskega dela v oceno predložiti dokazila o prvem avtorstvu umetniškega dela in o njegovi javni predstavitvi.

Doktorsko delo

Doktorsko delo je rezultat večletnega umetniškoraziskovalnega projekta. Pomeniti mora izviren prispevek k umetnosti, ki ga je pozitivno ocenila komisija za spremljanje doktorskega študenta. Doktorsko delo mora predvsem slediti trem načelom: obravnavani problem mora biti relevanten, študent mora obvladati metodologijo umetniškega raziskovanja in rezultati morajo pomeniti izviren prispevek k umetnosti.

Doktorsko delo je samostojen in izviren prispevek k izbrani temi umetniškega področja. Doktorsko delo je napisano v slovenskem jeziku z obsežnim povzetkom v angleškem jeziku.

Senat UL lahko izjemoma odobri izdelavo doktorskega dela v angleškem jeziku: če je kandidat tujec, če sta tujca kandidatov mentor ali somentor ali če je tujec član komisije.

Conditions for completing the programme

To successfully complete the study and obtain the artistic title of Doctor of Arts, a student must successfully fulfil all program-specified study requirements and publicly defend their doctoral work, amounting to a total of 240 ECTS. It is mandatory for the doctoral candidate to present the results of their artistic research work publicly at least once (when submitting the doctoral work for evaluation), as recognized by individual artistic disciplines. The doctoral candidate must provide evidence of being the primary author of the artistic work and its public presentation no later than when submitting the doctoral work for evaluation.

Doctoral thesis

The doctoral work is the result of a multi-year artistic research project and must represent an original contribution to the arts, positively assessed by the committee monitoring the doctoral student. The doctoral work must primarily adhere to three principles: the addressed problem must be relevant, the student must master the methodology of artistic research, and the results must constitute an original contribution to the arts.

The doctoral thesis is an independent and original contribution to the chosen topic within the artistic field. The doctoral thesis is written in the Slovenian language with an extensive summary in the English language.

The Senate of the University of Ljubljana may exceptionally approve the preparation of the doctoral thesis in the English language in the

Business sector

The employment opportunities for PhD graduates from the interdisciplinary doctoral programme Art in the economic sector are very broad and diverse due to the interdisciplinary nature of the programme. Graduates will work in key areas of the economy in the field of cultural and creative industries and the art market, as well as in the craft industry and the commercial sector (e.g., as consultants, specialists). They will be employable in design, architectural, film, artistic, musical, theatrical, gaming, advertising studios, and other economic entities that conduct creative processes. They will also constitute a large and important part of start-up projects and companies. Many will be able to find employment abroad.

Doctor of Arts will be able to integrate into the development (economic) sector, marketing (economic performance), and in the field of user understanding (humanism). Their orientation towards the economy enables the interdisciplinary nature of artistic disciplines as an activity that contributes as much as possible to the higher quality and competitiveness of products, services, and systems, thereby adding higher value. Created cultural and artistic surpluses are therefore one of the key drivers of economic success and bearers of culture and identity in society.

Non-Economic Sector

Doctor of Arts from the interdisciplinary doctoral programme Art will operate in key areas within the non-economic sector, wherever art and related forms of cultural and creative activities are involved in processes. They will confidently take on positions in public institutions (museums, galleries, philharmonics), public and state administration, non-governmental, and non-profit organizations. They can be employed in institutions requiring artistic education or those engaged in artistic research, production, and recreation (orchestras, choirs), both on an international and national level.

Doctor of Arts will be employable in cultural institutions in the fields of artistic activities and media. They will work in areas where their acquired research abilities are relevant (integration processes in society and pedagogical activities). Doctor of Arts can work in education at the university and higher education levels, demonstrating proficiency, independence, and proactivity in leading fundamental, applied, or

The Programme Council of the interdisciplinary doctoral programme in Art has eleven members: two members each from UL AG, UL AGRFT, UL ALUO, and one member each from UL BF, UL FA, UL FF, UL NTF, and UL PEF. The term of office of the Programme Council is four years. The seat of the Programme Council is at UL ALUO. After its term of office, the Programme Council continues to perform tasks until the constitution of the new one, which is appointed by the Senate of the University of Ljubljana.

Interdisciplinarni doktorski študij Umetnost urejajo pravila, s katerimi sta določena način in organizacija izvedbe doktorskega študijskega programa:

1. Univerza objavi skupni razpis za vpis v doktorske študijske programe 3. stopnje, ki opredeljuje trajanje študija, vpisne pogoje, kraj izvajanja, način študija in število vpisnih mest tudi za doktorski študijski program Umetnost.
2. Kandidat za študij odda prijavo prek portala eVŠ in jo podpisano pošlje na naslov članice, kjer je zaposlen potencialni mentor, oz. na fakulteto/akademijo, na kateri želi kandidat študirati.
3. Kandidat pred vpisom izbere mentorja z izbranega umetniškega področja in pripravi kratko idejno zasnovo umetniškoraziskovalnega dela.
4. Študent in fakulteta/akademija ob vpisu na doktorski študij podpišeta pogodbo o izobraževanju.
5. Vpis in vse postopke v zvezi s pridobitvijo umetniškega naslova izvede članica, ki je koordinatorica umetniškega področja.
6. Članica v celoti organizira in skrbi za izvedbo doktorskega programa na področjih, ki jih koordinira:
 - Senatu UL predlaga člane programskega sveta,
 - imenuje koordinatorja področja,
 - vodi evidence v zvezi s študijem in študenti,
 - organizira in skrbi za izvedbo predavanj in ostalih študijskih obveznosti pri svojih predmetih (izvajalci, prostor, urniki, obveščanje izvajalcev in študentov idr.),
 - v sodelovanju z mentorjem organizira in se dogovori za izvedbo študijskih obveznosti, ki jih izvajajo druge fakultete (izbirni predmeti),
 - poda poročilo o izvedbi programa posameznega področja programskemu svetu.
7. Postopek za prijavo dispozicije doktorske disertacije vodi senat članice, kjer je kandidat

The Interdisciplinary doctoral programme in ART adheres to principles of Rules and Regulations on Doctoral Studies dealing with its mode and implementation as follows:

1. The University of Ljubljana publishes the Call for Enrolment into the Doctoral Programme in Art. The call for enrolment has to adhere to the Statute of the University of Ljubljana and includes guidelines for artistic fields selection as well as information on available number of study places.
2. The candidate should submit their application for enrolment electronically on the web portal eVŠ and sends their application to the address of the member faculty/academy at which their mentor is employed, or at which the candidate intends to study.
3. Before enrolment, the candidate chooses a mentor from the selected field of art and prepares a brief conceptual design of the artistic research work.
4. The candidate and the faculty/academy sign an education contract upon enrolment in the doctoral study programme.
5. The enrolment and all procedures necessary to obtain the doctoral degree are in the domain of the faculty that coordinates the respective artistic field.

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- Ensuring the regular implementation of the study process;
- Ensuring the coordination of work with students, mentors and lecturers;
- Ensuring timely replacement of absent teachers in the study process;
- Supervising the improvement and updating of study programmes by:
 - Submitting proposals to the senate of the parent faculty;
 - Co-signing student curricula;
 - Participating in the preparation of annual reports on the implementation of the study programme.
